Vaccination Services

General Practice Cremorne provides vaccination services to meet your **general immunisation** and **travel immunisation** requirements.

To ensure you understand the services we offer we have expanded on the **Consultation fee** and Vaccine fee description for your information.

The **Vaccine fee** is the cost charged to you for the vaccine you received. Please see current vaccine pricing opposite.

Some **vaccines are free** to certain patient groups for example;

- **Year 7 School** vaccinations
- **Flu vaccinations** to anyone over sixty five and or anyone with a chronic disease

For more information about your eligibility for free vaccinations please ask one of our Nursing staff.

Whilst some vaccines are free you will always be charged a **Consultation/service fee**.

If you want to discuss other health issues with your doctor your vaccinations can be combined with a normal GP Consultation. The **Consultation fee** in this instance is as per GP's normal charge.

Travel Health Consultation

- We **offer Travel Health Vaccination** and are an approved **Yellow Fever Centre**.
- Please call and speak to one of the Nurses about making your appointment with the GP.
- Prior to your GP **consultation** one of our nurses will collect the necessary clinical and travel information from you. We will organise a MASTA report which advises you on the Vaccinations required for your travel. \$10
- The Nurse will arrange a consultation with the GP for the travel management plan and vaccinations to be organised .
